

NC VOTER PHOTO ID REQUIREMENTS

All voters will be asked to show photo ID when voting in North Carolina.

Voters may respond to the request in several ways as listed below.

Present any one of the following that is unexpired or has not been expired for more than one year:

- NC Drivers License,
- State ID Card issued by the NC DMV,
- US Passport Book or Card
- NC Voter ID Card issued by your county BOE
- College/University student ID's approved by the State Board of Elections (see SBOE.gov for details)
- Drivers license/non-driver ID from another state - *(only if the voter has registered in NC within 90 days of the election)*
- Either of the following approved by the State Board of Elections:
 - State & Local Government ID
 - Charter School Employee ID (See the full list at:
<https://www.ncsbe.gov/voting/voter-id#acceptable>)

Voters may also present any of the following regardless if they contain an issuance or expiration date:

U. S. Military or Veteran ID Card

Tribal Card issued by State or Federally recognized tribes

Public assistance ID card issued by the U.S. Government or state of North Carolina

NOTE: Voters age 65+ may use an expired ID if it was unexpired on their 65th birthday

NEED AN ID? A registered voter, who does not have an acceptable ID for voting, can get a FREE ID Card from the Pamlico County Board of Elections. No special documents are required; just your name, date of birth and last 4 digits of your Social Security number.

Remember, if you are at the polls and do not have an acceptable ID, you can still cast your ballot. Per the State Board of Elections:

All voters will be able to vote with or without an ID. **If a voter casting a ballot at the voting site cannot provide an acceptable ID,**

1) the voter may fill out a Photo ID Exception Form (see reverse side) and vote a provisional ballot, or

2) vote a provisional ballot and bring an acceptable ID to the county board of elections office by the day before the county canvass (which is typically 10 days after elections in even-numbered years and seven days after elections in odd-numbered years).

ID Exceptions Form Details

If any voter is unable to show photo ID when voting (whether in person or by mail), they may fill out an ID Exception Form and vote their ballot. The voter will choose from the following permitted exceptions:

(1) The voter has a “reasonable impediment” to showing photo ID. This means that something is preventing the voter from showing ID. The voter must provide their reason by selecting from the following choices on the form.

Lack of transportation

Disability or illness

Lack of birth certificate or other documents needed to obtain ID

Work or school schedule

Family responsibilities

Photo ID is lost, stolen, or misplaced

Applied for photo ID but have not received it

For mail voters only: Unable to attach a copy of photo ID (Voter must include driver’s license number or last four digits of Social Security number)

Other reasonable impediment (if selected, the voter must write the reason on the form)

State or federal law prohibits voter from listing the reason

(2) The voter has a religious objection to being photographed.

(3) The voter was a victim of a natural disaster within 100 days before Election Day that resulted in a disaster declaration by the President of the United States or the Governor of North Carolina.

County boards of elections must count provisional ballots with properly completed ID Exception Forms.
